The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. April 4, 2023 adjourned from March 28, 2023.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the Minutes from the March 28, 2023 Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for April 4, 2023. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary Road matters including snow removal last Saturday, hauling rock, and starting work orders. Gravel crushing will start May 1st and will be done before Memorial Day.
