Work and budget reports were reviewed.

The board was presented with a review of program and nature center attendance for our 1<sup>st</sup> full year of the center being open.

There was a discussion about grants being pursued through REAP and the Iowa Prairie Network for nature center displays and seeding projects.

An update was given on trying to acquire a disk for fire line construction and food plot tillage. No action was taken and we will continue to pursue other options.

An update on the building repairs was given and information from Martin Gardner Inc. was disseminated to the board.

The board revisited the proposed land swap proposal that would trade 7 acres of wooded railway bed south of C.A. Block for 7 acres of existing farm ground on the northeast corner of Dan Ryerson's field to the east of the rail bed. Dan would pay the cost to have the area restored to prairie. Further information was needed to weigh all options and no action was taken.
