The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. June 9, 2026 adjourned from June 2, 2026.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Durby, and Smith

Absent:

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the June 2, 2026 Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for June 9, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Kris Oswald, Drainage Clerk discussed Drainage matters.

Oswald discussed the DD 92 Reclassification from 2019. It was discovered some laterals were not built but were drawn on a map. To correct this, per Jacobson Westergard the engineer, these laterals need to be abandoned. On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve abandoning laterals in DD 92 which were never constructed. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Scott Meinders, Engineer discussed Secondary Road matters including the Dust Pods, gravel stabilization project, dust should be minimal and road should need very minimal blading. The project needs a lot of water, between 12,000 and 15,000 gallons per mile.

The Supervisors tabled the Nuisance Ordinance until next week.

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve moving forward to negotiations on an easement on railroad property in Newton Township. All voted aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the Supervisors moved to approve the Canvass for the 2026 Primary Election, including the information below. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Whereas, the Primary Election was held as prescribed by law on June 2, 2026, now be it hereby resolved that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and the ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Winnebago County, Iowa do hereby certify the outcome, in accordance with Iowa Code 43.49, the votes cast in the Primary election held June 2, 2026.

894 (eight hundred ninety-four) people voted at the polls on Election Day.

151 (one hundred fifty-one) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

0 (zero) provisional ballots were accepted for counting.

1045 (one thousand forty-five) people total voted.
