The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. July 21, 2026, adjourned from July 14, 2026.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Durby, and Smith

Absent:

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the July 14, 2026, Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for July 21, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

At 9:00 A.M. on a motion by Jensvold and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to go into closed session to discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of Winnebago County in such litigation per Iowa Code 21.5(1)(c). Roll call vote, Durby – Aye, Jensvold – Aye, Smith - Aye. Motion carried.

On a motion by Smith and seconded by Durby the supervisors moved to come back into open session. All voted aye. Motion carried. There was no action taken.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO A CHAPTER 28E INTERGOVERNMENTAL
COOPERATION AGREEMENT**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDED
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE CHAPTER 28E BETWEEN
CENTRAL IOWA JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER AND PARTICIPATING IOWA COUNTIES.**

WHEREAS, Winnebago County previously entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 28E with Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center (CIJDC) and other participating entities, which was filed with the Iowa Secretary of State on June 27th, 2012 as Filing Number M505282 and

WHEREAS, the participating entities have determined that updates, modifications, and amendments to the original 28E Agreement are necessary

WHEREAS, Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center has already officially approved and executed the proposed Amended 28E Agreement in accordance with all current requirements; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has reviewed the updated agreement, a copy of which is on file with the County Auditor, and finds that approving these updates is in the best interest of the County and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Winnebago County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The updated and amended 28E Intergovernmental Agreement by and between Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center and the participating entities is hereby approved in all respects.

Section 2. The board appointed CIJDC representative is hereby authorized and directed to execute the updated Agreement on behalf of Winnebago County.

Section 3. Upon execution by all parties, Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center is directed to file the fully executed, amended Agreement with the Iowa Secretary of State as required by Iowa Code Section 28E.8.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

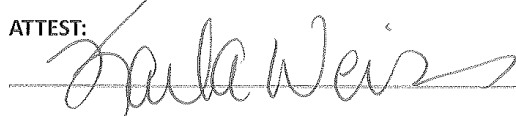

RESOLUTION No. 07-21-26-20-001

Establishing Weight Restrictions on Winnebago County Bridges

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors has authority under Sections 321.236, 321.255 and 321.471 through 321.473 of the Code of Iowa to erect signs for weight restrictions on bridges on any Secondary Road after the completion of an engineering study, and

WHEREAS the Winnebago County Engineer has completed or has caused to be completed the Structure Inventory and Appraisal of certain Winnebago County bridges in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards, and

WHEREAS, the results of these inspections and reviews indicate that certain structures have reduced load carrying capability and require load restrictions, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Winnebago County Board of Supervisors, that the Winnebago County Engineer be authorized to provide, erect and maintain appropriate signs to establish the safe load capacities and width restrictions for the structures listed on Attachment A, which is made a part of this resolution, and that this posting is legal and enforceable under the provisions of the Code of Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution supersedes any previous resolutions pertaining to load limits or width restriction for Winnebago County bridges.

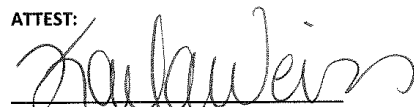
