The Winnebago County Board of Supervisors met in session at 9:00 A.M. July 28, 2026, adjourned from July 21, 2026.

Present: Supervisors Jensvold, Durby, and Smith

On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to approve the minutes for the July 21, 2026, Board Meeting and approve the Agenda for July 28, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

There was discussion regarding the fence at Benny Hostleter's property. The Supervisors would like the fence to be at the request of the Zoning Administrator. They would also like a living fence to cover the metal fence. The fence should not go all the way to the tip of the property due to snow issues. This will be on the agenda August 11, 2026 at 10:00 A.M.

At 9:30 A.M. There was a public hearing to discuss the Amendment to Nuisance Ordinance #5. On a motion by Durby and seconded by Smith the Supervisors moved to open the Public Hearing. All voted aye.
